1 Timothy 3:15 (CSB)

...I have written so that you will know how people ought to conduct themselves in God's household, which is the church of the living God, the pillar and foundation of the truth.

Truth is alive.

- God is <u>authentic</u>: He opens himself to be known personally and genuinely. (Jeremiah 10:10; John 1:14)
- God is <u>trustworthy</u>: He speaks honestly and accurately.
 (Numbers 23:19; Titus 1:2)
- God is <u>faithful</u>: He always does what he says he will do. (Isaiah 46:11; 1 Thessalonians 5:23)

Truth wielded properly produces trust.

(2 Thessalonians 2:10, Ephesians 4:20-21)

- When we're open we are willing to be known. (1 John 1:5-7)
- When we're honest we speak the truth about God, ourselves, and others. (Ephesians 4:25)
- We do these things with <u>discretion</u>, learning what is appropriate and helpful. (Eph. 4:15; Philippians 1:9)

- Live an honest, open life before others.
 (Ephesians 4:25, 1 John 1:7)

 (Matthew 5:23-24, Colossians 3:13)
- 12. Participate in the ministry. (1 Peter 4:10, Ephesians 4:16)
- 13. Support the work financially. (1 Corinthians 16:2, 2 Corinthians 9:6-7)
- 14. Follow spiritual leadership within Scriptural limits. (Hebrews 13:17, 1 Peter 5:5-7)
