It requires an uncommon commitment which...

- Displays humility. (Ruth 1:8; Philippians 2:4)
- Endures hardship. (Ruth 1:11; Matthew 5:46; John 12:24)
- Deals **honestly**. (Ruth 1:13, 20-21; Psalm 10:1, 22:1)
- Holds on tightly. (Ruth 1:16-17, 22; Jeremiah 31:3)
